Project update

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will soon begin works to rehabilitate a 2.7 kilometre stretch of pavement on the Bruce Highway between Fleming Road and Vantage Road in Chatsworth, north of Gympie.

Works will commence in the coming weeks and are expected to be complete by October 2024, weather and other conditions permitting.

Project details

The upcoming works will include excavating the pavement to fix underlying geotechnical issues that have resulted in frequent potholing, rutting and other problems at this location. These upgrades will improve road safety and comfort for motorists.

This project completes the planned program of pavement works for the Bruce Highway at Chatsworth.

Construction impacts

Works will occur at night between 6.00pm and 6.00am, Sunday to Thursday. Some periodic work outside of these hours may be required.

During the works motorists should expect some delays, speed restrictions, lane closures and are reminded to observe all warning and traffic control signage when approaching the works site and be aware of changed conditions.

During the nightworks, nearby residents and motorists may experience the following:

- Audible construction noise and vibration:
 Heavy machinery will be in use during the
 work period, resulting in localised noise and
 potential vibration impacts. The project team
 will take steps to reduce these impacts where
 possible.
- Construction dust: Construction activities may generate some dust impacts. The project team will monitor dust levels and implement water trucks, as required.
- Temporary access restrictions: The project team will endeavour to minimise property access restrictions and will provide early advice to property owners of imminent access disruptions where possible
