

Important notice

Flinders Highway (Townsville - Charters Towers) Macrossan Bridge deck resurfacing project

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise that deck resurfacing works will soon occur on the Macrossan Bridge on the Flinders Highway between Townsville and Charters Towers.

TMR will delivered these works in three stages across August and September 2023, including two day works packages and a night works package.



Day works package one:

6am to 6pm **Tuesday 29 August to** Day works package two:

6am to 6pm Friday 15 September to Thursday 7 September 2023 Thursday 21 September 2023

All work is subject to construction progress and weather conditions

Works will be completed as routine safety improvements to the road surface on Macrossan Bridge including:

- pressure washing and application of deck waterproofing skid resistance treatment
- new line marking of each section of the Macrossan Bridge.

What to expect during works hours:

- The Macrossan Bridge will have changed traffic conditions including lane closures, reduced speed limits and short delays
- Wide Load vehicles will not be permitted to cross the bridge during the delivery of this package of works.
- Traffic controllers will be on-site while works are underway and to ensure priority access through the work zone for emergency services only (non-emergency service vehicles will not be permitted to travel through the work zone for any reason)

Night works

The delivery of package three requires a temporary closure of the Macrossan Bridge over three nights between the hours of 7pm to 5am Monday 11 September, Tuesday 12 September and Wednesday 13 September. During this time the Macrossan Bridge will reopen each day from 5am to 7pm during the works period.
