

Important notice – Night works closure Flinders Highway (Townsville – Charters Towers) Macrossan Bridge deck resurfacing project

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise that Macrossan Bridge on the Flinders Highway between Townsville and Charters Towers will be temporarily closed over three nights to allow for resurfacing works to be completed on the bridge.

Traffic will not be able to cross the bridge each night on:

Monday 11, Tuesday 12 and Wednesday 13 September 2023 between 7pm and 5am

(*All work is subject to construction progress and weather conditions)

The Macrossan Bridge will reopen to traffic each day from 5am to 7pm during the works period.

Traffic controllers and the Queensland Police Service will be onsite while works are underway; access will be maintained for emergency services vehicles if required.

Motorists who travel this area at night are asked to consider alternative routes on the nights of Monday 11, Tuesday 12 and Wednesday 13 September, to avoid the closure period.

These works are being delivered in addition to day works on the bridge from 6am to 6pm daily, between Tuesday 29 August to Thursday 7 September 2023.



Single lane closures on the bridge during these day works (29 August to 7 September 2023) and will result in traffic delays during active work hours.
