

Bruce Highway, southbound, resurfacing

Work notification: August 2024

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) will be undertaking resurfacing works on the southbound carriageway of the Bruce Highway, between the Parklands interchange and the Kiel Mountain Road overpass, including resurfacing and rehabilitation to the ramps at the Bli Bli interchange.

Key works

- · Resurfacing the southbound carriageway.
- Resurfacing and rehabilitation of the on and off-ramps at the Bli Bli interchange.
- These works do not include the roundabouts at the Bli Bli interchange or the ramps at the Parklands interchange.



What to expect

- Works are scheduled to begin in mid-August 2024 and will take up to six weeks to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting.
- These works will be undertaken at **night between 6pm and 6am**, requiring one lane to be closed. Weekend works and works during the day may be required.
- Detours will be required for short periods during works at the Bli Bli interchange. These will be signed with Variable Message Boards (VMS) before and during the works.
- Reduced speed limits, construction signage and traffic control will be in place to ensure motorist and roadworker safety. Motorists are encouraged to drive to the changed traffic conditions.
- Emergency services will be given priority access through the work site.

Motorists are urged to check 13 19 40 or Queensland Traffic (qldtraffic.qld.gov.au) for updates. TMR's contractor will endeavour to keep disruptions and noise to a minimum while the works are undertaken. TMR understands roadworks can be frustrating for nearby businesses, residents, and road users, and acknowledges the cooperation and patience of stakeholders during works.


