

# Important notice – temporary road closure

## Flinders Highway (Charters Towers – Hughenden) Warrigal Creek bridge deck repair project

The Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) would like to advise that Warrigal Creek Bridge on the Flinders Highway approximately 124km west of Charters Towers will be temporarily closed for a period to allow for bridge deck works to be completed.

Traffic will not be able to cross the bridge on:

**Friday 27 September 2024  
between 9am and 1pm**

*(\*All work is subject to construction progress and weather conditions)*

Works are currently underway on the Warrigal Creek Bridge to repair the bridge deck surface and this temporary closure is required to complete repairs not accessible while the bridge is trafficked.

Traffic controllers and the Queensland Police Service will be onsite while works are underway; access will be maintained for emergency services vehicles if required.

Motorists who travel this area are asked to consider alternative routes or travel plans to avoid the **four-hour** closure period on **Friday 27 September 2024**.

These works are being delivered in addition to day works on the bridge from 7am to 5pm daily, until Friday 4 October, 2024.

### Important notice regarding vehicle width restrictions:

Vehicle width restrictions are currently in place. Heavy vehicle operators with loads 3.2 meters wide or greater must contact the project team on 0418 743 227 at least 24 hours prior to anticipated time of arrival to arrange for infrastructure to be cleared. Failure to give advance warning will result in delays to travel through the works area.
